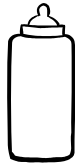

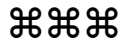

PASTOR'S PARAGRAPH

A spy was captured and sentenced to death by a Persian general. This general had the strange custom of giving condemned criminals a choice between the firing squad and the big, black door. As the moment for execution drew near, the general asked the spy, "What will it be: the firing squad or the big, black door?" The spy hesitated for a long time—it was a hard decision. In the end, he chose the firing squad, and moments later he was dead. The general turned to his aide and said, "They always prefer the known way to the unknown. It's characteristic of people to be afraid of the undefined." The aide said, "What lies beyond the big, black door?" "Freedom," replied the general. "I've known only a few brave enough to take it." When you think about it, that story reminds us of the importance of Jesus' resurrection. Before Jesus arose, death looked like a big, black mystery that kept us in fear—but since we know He's alive forevermore, the mystery has been solved and we can choose freedom and life by choosing Him! Paul writes, "as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive" (1 Cor. 15:22). Because of Easter, we no longer have to be reconciled to the idea of death—we can choose to live! Praise His glorious name! That's a little more powerful message than the one about the bunny and the eggs, isn't it?
