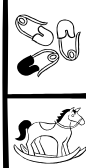
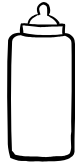

PASTOR'S PARAGRAPH

Mothers have an incredible responsibility, and sometimes it can be downright overwhelming. The story's told of a woman who telephoned a friend and asked how she was feeling. "Terrible," came the reply. "My head's splitting, my back and legs are killing me, the house is a mess, and the kids are driving me crazy." Very sympathetically the caller said, "Listen, go lie down, and I'll come over and cook lunch for you, do some cleaning, and take care of the children while you get some rest. By the way, how is Sam?" "Sam?" the complaining woman said. "My husband's name isn't Sam." "My heavens," the caller said, "I must've dialed the wrong number." There was a pause, then the mother asked, "Well, are you still coming over?" No wonder the writer of **Proverbs 31** asked the question, **"Who can find a virtuous wife? For her worth is far above rubies"** (Proverbs 31:10). We all need to recognize what moms are worth not only in terms of the physical things they do, but also in terms of the emotional and spiritual support they provide, and we need to remind them of their worth not just on Mothers' Day but all year long. If your mom is still with you, show her love and tell her you thank God for her. If your mom is in heaven, as mine is, take time to let the Lord know how grateful you are that He gave her to you for a little while.
